$$3 \times 6 = 18 \quad 6 \times 3 = 18 \quad 18 \div 6 = 3 \quad 18 \div 3 = 6 \quad 30 \times 6 = 180 \quad 60 \times 30 = 180$$

Some help to get these into the maths brain would be greatly appreciated!
