

News from the Classes

This week in Maths, **KS1** have been measuring. They compared the weight of different objects and practised reading scales. In English we have created some super non-fiction texts and used the internet well to research our chosen insect.

KS1 can come dressed in their pyjamas for World Book Day (Friday, 3rd March) but could they please have appropriate footwear for outside (they can bring slippers to change into.)

KS2: The illustrations for the Mr Benn stories are looking fantastic. The detail in the art backgrounds will inspire the Mr Benn stories that are now in composition.

In the Enterprise Project we have looked at where food comes from and how far it travels. This, of course, explains why some products, or stock, are more expensive than others.

Reading

After half term we are going to be promoting reading by offering a Headteacher award to KS1 children for reading 10 books and KS2 for 5 books (assuming they are thicker books than KS1!) This could also be books read using e-readers. Please use the children's reading record book to let us know when your child has read a book.

During the first week back after the holiday we intend to ensure that all KS2 and year 2 children have a tablet to use as an e-reader. The App for RM Books will be downloaded – this App also allows children to change background colour.

If you wish your child to use their own tablet please download the App so they are able to join in. Do ask us for help if there are any problems.
