Welcome Back and Termly Reports

Welcome back to what will be a very busy and enjoyable summer term, full of trips, plays, sports events and learning!

Following the positive feedback received from parents regarding the short termly reports sent out at the start of last term, we have decided to continue providing these. You should receive these early next week (if you have not done so already).

PE Sessions

From next week, Oaks will have PE sessions on Thursdays (instead of Friday) with Mrs Wardell. They should come to school in PE kit on this day. Mrs Wardell currently works at Glaisdale Primary School, joining our trust in January following her role as Head of Sport at Bridlington Secondary School. We are very fortunate to have her expertise and are now sharing these with children at Castleton.

As you may be aware, there are upcoming teacher strikes on 27/04/23 and 02/05/23. At this stage, we are anticipating that our school will be unaffected by these strikes and will be open as usual. If this situation changes, we will endeavour to contact you as soon as possible.

End of School Day Time Change

Thank you for your support with the changing of our school finish time. We are hoping that this trial will prove successful but recognise that this may inevitably disrupt some families' evening plans. As stated in previous newsletters, the extension to the school day will be mandatory for all schools from September 2023, as per government policy. We are hoping that, by conducting this trial, we will be able to understand the best solution for as many families as possible. We will be holding a short questionnaire towards the end of this half-term to help us with this process.

Coffee Morning in Support of Year 6 Edinburgh Trip

Some of fabulous Year 6 children and their families, with the support of the PTFA, ran a community coffee morning on Saturday 15th April. It was a pleasure to see so many local residents come and support this event. It was commented on how well the children prepared their individual stalls, whether that was with games, cakes, teas/coffees (and hot chocolates!), sweets and face painting. The five Year 6 children involved managed to raise £333.50 – a fantastic amount! These children have now raised their funds for the Edinburgh trip as a result. Any additional proceeds will go towards Year 6 leavers' hoodies.

An MCAS item has been added to all Year 6 parent accounts to provide the £50 raised by children (whether at the coffee morning or through their own entrepreneurial activities). This will be the easiest way to transfer these funds to school and helps us to understand which children may require help at school to raise this money. For children who are unable to raise these funds themselves, we will be arranging some activities where children can do this at school, for example by helping to sell ice pops at the end of the school day in the warmer months!

Wellbeing Club

Wellbeing Club will recommence next week on Tuesday for children already in this club.
