## **Mrs Robinson**

Unfortunately, Mrs Clare Robinson (Breakfast Club Worker and Relief Teaching Assistant) will be leaving us at the end of this half-term. We will miss her sorely but want to thank her for all her hard work and flexibility during her time at Castleton and wish her lots of luck for her future endeavours.

Mrs (Gaby) Boyd will continue to run the Breakfast Club as normal after half-term with the same timings (7.45am onwards) and provision. There will be another member of staff on site to allow for this.

## **Meal Choices**

From the next week, our school kitchen will be provided an alternative option of jacket potato each day (with a choice of filling: cheese, beans or tuna). This will be served alongside any appropriate items from the main school meal option (e.g. vegetables). We hope that having an alternative option will allow children to have a choice on a day when there is a meal that is not preferred.

If children would like this choice, they will simply order on the morning during registration. The meal will be charged at the usual school meal price (£2.60) and will include the usual dessert option on that day.

#### SATs Week

Next week, all Year 6 children, in school and nationally, will complete their end of Key Stage 2 assessments in English and maths. These tests show children how far they have come at primary school and also show their new secondary school teachers where they need to go next. We have reassured children that they are well prepared for these with all the work they have done throughout primary school. We have also reassured children that they should just aim to do their best and not be disheartened if there are questions they cannot do – the whole point of a test is to see what your limit is.

Please encourage your Year 6 children to have a restful weekend; spend a short amount of time looking back through their SATs preparation work; get a good night's sleep and a good breakfast each day ahead of the week.

Children will have the following tests:

Tuesday – English spelling, punctuation and grammar (1 hour in total)

Wednesday – English reading (1 hour in total)

Thursday – Maths arithmetic and reasoning papers (1 hour 10 mins in total)

Friday – Maths reasoning paper (40 mins)

Some children may qualify for additional time depending on their needs

Please ensure children arrive at school promptly each morning for these assessments. If your child is ill/absent, please contact school immediately, as we may need to make alternative arrangements for any child missing a test. This may require them to avoid contact with other children who have sat the assessment already.

# SATs Week – Free Breakfast Club

During SATs Week (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> May), we will be offering free breakfast club provision for all our Year 6s, so that they have the opportunity to get a healthy breakfast and a chance to discuss (and remain calm about) the upcoming day's assessment.

# Key Stage 1 Trip – Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> May

Our Key Stage 1 children will be visiting Saltburn on Wednesday to take part in beach school and geography activities. They should come to school at the usual time in appropriate outdoor clothing/footwear; their school hoodie/jumper with a waterproof coat and sunhat. Packed lunches will be provided by school.

## **Outdoor Learning/PE**

There will be no outdoor learning next week due to the Acorns trip and SATs Week.

Oaks will have PE on Wednesday afternoon next week, so that this session does not clash with Thursday's SATs assessments. Children in Year 3-5 should come to school in PE kit. Children in Year 6 should come to school in uniform (to sit their assessments) with PE kit to change into afterwards.
