#### **School Timings Questionnaire**

Thank you to the parents that have completed our current questionnaire on proposed new school timings (based on government requirements). There is one more week to complete this if you haven't already (only complete once per household please). Currently, the majority of families are in favour of continuing with the current arrangement of a school day starting at 9am and finishing at 3.30pm. If this continues to be the case, we will work with the small number of individual families that may have had plans affected by the later finishing time where possible.

# School Meal Prices (from September 2023)

For the last two years, the school has been able to maintain its current meal price of £2.60. This is despite rising costs and an increase in what North Yorkshire County Caterers charge the school per meal (which has been £3.05 per meal since January 2023), meaning the school has been making a 'loss' of 45p per meal since that increase. This loss is significantly more for children that receive free school meals in Key Stage 1 as the government only provides funding up to £2.41 per meal (a 64p loss per meal).

To reduce the impact of this on school budgets, all Yorkshire Endeavour Academy Trust schools will raise its meal prices to parents to £2.75 per meal from September 2023. This represents a yearly increase of £28.50 (if a child has a school meal every day). Whilst we are reluctant to increase our prices during these difficult times, we hope you appreciate that the school is continuing to subsidise a significant proportion of this charge, ensuring children have as much opportunity to a hot school meal every day.

Children will be able to eat their regular meal for that day, as well as have the chance to taste the options listed below.

#### **Spare Uniform**

#### **Phonics Screening Week**

Next week, our Year 1 children will take part in a phonics screen. Information regarding this was sent out earlier in the week. The activities involved are low-key and designed not to put any unnecessary pressure on some of our youngest pupils. The children simply have to read the words shown to them, some of which are real words, some 'alien' words, using their phonic learning from the year to decode them. We will report their results later in the term.

#### Multiplication Tables Check – Year 4

Our Year 4 children will be taking their multiplication check next week. This asks children to complete 25 times table questions on the screen, similar to those they practise daily. Our children are well prepared for this, having this daily practice. The results of this will be shared later in the term.

#### Sports Club – Year 1-4

At the end of the last half-term we were gauging interest in a new sports club for our younger children. Unfortunately, we did not have enough interest for this.

Therefore, we are proposing to extend the offer of this club to children in Year 1-4. We also understand some children may now be able to attend who were unable to previously due to changes in other clubs they attend. 
