Dear Families and Friends,

Rockbottom

This week I was immensely proud (as I know the whole Castleton community was too) with our Oaks Class and their performance of *Rockbottom*. The children worked exceptionally hard to practise their lines, learn their cues, design and build their props/costumes and put together a fantastic spectacle which has been heavily praised throughout the community. Thank you to everyone that supported our children and contributed towards the PTFA fundraising activities, who raised £272.75. A massive thank you must also go to the staff who worked tirelessly to put on this performance and allow our children the opportunity to share their talent, in amongst all the other pressures schools have at this time of year.

Year 6 SATs Results

The Year 6 SATs results are due to be released on Tuesday 11th July (a week later than originally planned). This falls during the Year 6 transition week, so we aim to supply these via e-mail to parents on the release day. All other year groups' assessments will be shared in end of year reports.

Outdoor Learning

There will be no outdoor learning session for either class next week due to transition. All children will have a final session in the final full week of term.

Clubs - Autumn Term

We have made the provisional arrangements for clubs in the autumn term, so that families can make allowances for childcare. We will be asking parents in the new term about whether they would like paid-for childcare after school on days where there are no clubs for their child to attend (or if their child does not want to go to a particular club). Please do speak to Mr Cooper beforehand if you are interested in this (and have not already expressed this previously).

Year 2 – Free School Meals from September

As our current Year 2 children advance to Year 3 (and Key Stage 2) they will not be automatically eligible for universal infant free school meals, as they are now. Meals will, therefore, be charged at the new rate of £2.75 per meal (the new cost from September for all meals).

Transition Week

Next week, our children will be taking part in some form of transition at points in the week. Our Year 6 children will be spending time in their new secondary school; Year 2 children will spend time in their new class and we

will also be welcoming our new starters into school on Thursday morning and lunchtime. We understand how important effective transition is and we are looking forward to supporting all our children with these changes so they feel positive about these (and not daunted by them). Please feel free to contact your child's teacher (or new teacher) if you feel your child requires more support.

As Year 2 will be joining Oaks on Wednesday and Thursday, they should come to school in their PE kit on Wednesday to take part in PE this day with Mrs Wardell

MCAS Balances

Please can you now start to clear your MCAS balances in good time for the end of the academic year. We do not want to unnecessarily chase up parents, so please get in touch if you require an additional payment plan or if you plan to clear your balance closer to the end of the academic year.

Acorns Trip to Whitby

On Monday, our youngest class will be visiting Whitby as part of their history learning. They will take time to learn about Captain Cook, as well as have a chance to sail on the Bark Endeavour. Please ensure children arrive to school on time wearing their uniform with a packed lunch (provided by home). They will also need a water bottle, sun hat and sun cream or a waterproof jacket depending on the weather. Children should bring a small rucksack to carry their belongings for the day. They will return before the end of the school day.

Year 5 Bikeability

Next week, on Wednesday and Thursday, our Year 5 children will be taking part in their Bikeability training, where they will learn about the importance of road safety through cycling. They will be led by external trained instructors who will build their confidence on our playground before advancing to some of the quieter roads/areas around the village. Please ensure all permission and consent forms are returned ahead of the sessions. Please also ensure that children come to school in appropriate clothing (e.g. PE kit) with their bike and helmet.

Summer Fair

The Summer Fair will take place at school on Thursday 20th July, from 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm. Oak Class have been busy planning various games and activities for everyone to enjoy throughout the afternoon. The PTFA team will provide refreshments and a BBQ and other stallholders from the local area will be present. We are sure this will be a fun community event and look forward to seeing you there.

Sports Day

Sports Day will take place at the cricket field on Tuesday 18th July, from 1.30 to 3.30 pm. All children should arrive at school in their P.E. kit, wearing a suitable top representing their team colour. Please make sure your child brings a hat and wears plenty of sun cream. There will be a carousel of events like last year and refreshments will be available from the PTFA team. Please make arrangements to collect your child from the cricket field at the end of the day. (Taxi children will return to school for collection if needed.)
