Dear Families and Friends,

General Teaching Assistant (SEND)

I am pleased to announce that we successfully appointed Ms Helen Searle to our team this week as one of our GTA (SEND) in Key Stage 2, replacing Mrs Sophie Wilson, who will leave us at the end of term. Ms Searle joins us having worked in various settings supporting children with special educational needs, including in special schools and SEND departments in mainstream provision. Ms Searle will predominantly be working with children with specific needs, however, like Sophie, she will also support other children with their learning and school experiences. Ms Searle is due to start with us after Easter, at which point I know you will all make her feel very welcome to the team.

Mrs Victoria Napoleon and Teaching Assistant Support in Oaks and Acorns

Sadly, we will be losing another team member in quick succession. Mrs Napoleon will also be leaving us at the end of term to start a new position at Roseville Nursery. Mrs Napoleon joined us last year in Oaks, to provide extra additional adult support until December 2023. Fortunately, due to additional funding being sourced, Mrs Napoleon was able to join us for longer, supporting children in both classes. However, this contract/funding was due to end in August and we support Mrs Napoleon's decision to find a long-term position.

Therefore, we currently have two job adverts posted for:

- An advanced/higher level teaching assistant to support Oaks full time (to replace Mr Wadley)
- A part-time teaching assistant to support Acorns on Mondays and Tuesdays (to replace Mrs Napoleon)

We, therefore, once again, would appreciate your support sharing our social media posts and these adverts with other community members who may be interested and suitable for these positions.

In the interim period, to ensure that children have a good amount of adult support, we will be welcoming two new temporary team members.

In Oaks, Mrs Pauline Laverick will be joining Oaks every morning. Mrs Laverick is a former headteacher who now provides supply cover in schools. This will mean that Oaks will have two qualified teachers leading them through maths and English sessions. Mrs Laverick has just finished a similar placement at Glaisdale School and has a wealth of other experience in teaching this age group. She will be a valuable asset whilst we recruit a permanent member of staff.

In Acorns, we will be joined by Miss Holly Chippindale on Mondays and Tuesdays. Miss Chippindale is studying for her TA qualification. However, she has recently volunteered at Glaisdale School, supporting their youngest class and has performed magnificently. She, too, will be a valued team member.

This means that, despite some changing of staff, we will have a full complement of staff after Easter (all being well!) Thank you for your patience and understanding during the last term whilst we have been arranging new staff and replacing those staff leaving us this term.

Eskdale Festival

We are so proud of all our musicians and performers who took part in the Eskdale Festival of the Arts this week. We had the most entries of any school in the area, despite having the furthest to travel and being one of the smallest schools. In total we achieved:

6x 1st places; 13x 2nd places and 4x 3rd places

Peat Rigg Residential
