Phoebe Update

I am pleased to say that Phoebe has now been transferred to York Hospital where she is doing well and will continue to stay until (approximately) her due date: 27th March. After School Care

As discussed in previous newsletters, we are hoping to provide after-school childcare in the very near future. We have now secured staffing for this and are in the process of confirming other logistics. We hope to have this in place in February.

The service will run from 3.15-5.15pm each day. Mrs (Sophie) Wilson will co-ordinate the club.

Please note: this will be a paid for service. For children attending between 3.15-4.15pm, parents will be charged £3. If a child attends after 4.15pm (until 5.15pm at the latest) the total charge for that child will be £5. There will be small discounts for additional siblings attending the club. Children will be provided with a small snack/drink as part of this service.

Please note: this club will be provided on a trial basis, so that we can understand its viability. This will continue until the end of the summer term, although we may make changes sooner if there are time slots that are not popular.

We will confirm the start date of this service in due course.

Swimming

Unfortunately, due to the weather on Monday, our transport provider was unable to take us to swimming. We are hoping to make up for this session later in the term by adding an additional date. We will confirm this once arrangements have been confirmed with the pool/transport provider.
