School Day Extension Trial – Summer Term

As discussed in previous newsletters and following the last parental survey, the school will be trialling a new finish time of 3.30pm after the Easter holiday. This is to move the school in-line with the government requirement to provide a 32.5-hour week by September 2023. We welcome any feedback you may have on this once it begins.

The start time will remain the same with children being dropped off from 8.50am, ready for a 9am start to the school day. Any arrivals after 9am will be marked as late.

All clubs will continue to run for 1-hour, finishing at 4.30pm, unless otherwise stated.

Poverty Proofing

This week, we were joined by two Poverty Proof auditors from within the Yorkshire Endeavour Academy Trust. They analysed information in school, spoke to parents, staff and children about how the cost of living crisis is affecting them (especially in school). Their report recommendations will be made available after Easter which we will look to share with you all. Thank you to all those that responded to the survey sent out earlier in the week.
