After Christmas, we will expect students to complete these papers independently, gaining any help in school, so we are able to understand what support children require before their assessments in May.

Our older pupils had an excellent day at Oakridge Primary School on Tuesday. In the morning, they met Paralympic gold medallist, Stephen Miller, who spoke about his life in sport and how he has overcome obstacles in his journey to Paralympic glory. Stephen then led children through a fitness circuit.

In the afternoon, the children had the opportunity to meet Adisa, a performance poet, and take part in an interactive workshop where they got to perform their own poetry.

PE/Forest School
