World Book Day

As I shared with some of you during our parents reading afternoon at the end of last half-term, a group of kind and thoughtful parents are making a bank of World Book Day costumes so that these can be accessed by all children ahead of the day (Thursday 7th March). This Poverty Proof friendly approach will allow all children, regardless of their background, to access a non-uniform World Book Day in a way that does not exclude. The Yorkshire Endeavour Academy Trust has, therefore, agreed that Castleton (and other schools with the same approach) can dress up for this day.

Children will be given the opportunity to borrow one of the costumes from this bank at the end of a school day on Thursday 29th February (3pm onwards) prior to World Book Day. However, children are still welcome to bring their own costume from home if they wish.
