Teaching Assistant Recruitment

We are pleased to announce that we successfully appointed Miss Holly Chippindale to our team this week. Miss Chippindale has been volunteering at Glaisdale and Castleton School for the last term, whilst she completes her advanced teaching assistant qualification. She now joins our Castleton Family on Mondays and Tuesdays in Acorns, supporting Mrs Barber. The children have already warmed to her infectious personality; we all know she will be a good fit for our team. We have readvertised our one remaining vacancy – the higher-level teaching assistant post in Oaks. We hope, with improved terms, that this will attract another suitable candidate.

Swimming

We started our swimming lessons this week, much to the enjoyment of our children!

Thank you to all parents/children for following our message regarding wearing costumes underneath their uniform at the start of the day. Although this helped speed up changing time when we arrived at the pool, we noticed that it made it very difficult for children to go to the toilet during the first part of the morning when they were in school, especially the youngest children. Therefore, <u>please can we request</u> that children only come to school with their swimwear underneath their uniform if they are capable of easily removing this independently, in the event they need the toilet. We have allowed enough time for children to change into their swimwear when we arrive at the pool.

Please can we also ask that children do not wear two-piece bathing suits – these are not permitting by the swimming baths. Thank you for your support.

Key Stage 2 Trip to Middlesbrough

On Thursday, our Key Stage 2 children will be visiting Middlesbrough, as part of their RE and art learning. They will be visiting a Gurdwara, learning how Sikhs worship and live their lives according to their religion. The children will then visit Middlesbrough Institute of Modern Art (MIMA) to enhance the art knowledge they have acquired this year. A consent form has been sent out for this – please complete if you haven't already done so. There will be no cost to parents on this occasion.

Acorns Trip to The Hanging Stones, Rosedale (Thursday 2nd May)

As part of their art focus on Andy Goldsworthy, Acorns will be visiting The Hanging Stones, Rosedale, where they will get to visit a range of this artist's exhibits. A separate letter will be sent shortly containing more information. The visit will take place within school hours during the afternoon, so there will be no need to provide consent or a packed lunch. Children should, however, come to school in weather-appropriate outdoor clothing, similar to that which they wear for forest school.
