# **PE/Forest School in Autumn**

Oaks will continue to have weekly PE sessions on Friday afternoons with Mrs Wardell.

Acorns will now have PE sessions on Monday afternoons with Mrs Barber (starting from 9<sup>th</sup> September).

Oaks will have fortnightly sessions of Forest Schools with Mrs Barber on Tuesday afternoons (starting from 10<sup>th</sup> September). This will alternate on a weekly basis with Year 3/4 having their first session on Tues 10<sup>th</sup> September and Year 5/6 having theirs on Tues 17<sup>th</sup> September.

#### **Nut Allergy**

#### **Music Lessons**

Music lessons with Mrs Lillie will start again next Tuesday. Thank you to all have responded and have completed the online consent form. Sorry, but Mrs Lillie's group for this year is now full. Should you wish that your child is added to Mrs Lillie's waiting list, please get in touch. As a reminder, music lessons cost £8 per session, which may be paid in a lump sum each half-term or weekly. If your child misses a lesson due to illness or holiday, payment will still be expected as a retainer. If lessons are unpaid within a reasonable time, your child's place will be offered to another child on the waiting list. If you are experiencing difficulties in paying, please contact school.

#### **Tapestry - Year 1 Parents/Carers**

We use Tapestry as a means of recording learning for our Early Years children. As your child is now in year one and following the KS1 curriculum we will no longer use the Tapestry platform. 
