## **Ofsted Inspection – Thank You!**

I must start this week's newsletter with a wholehearted 'thank you' to all of our Castleton family and friends who rallied around us this week during our Ofsted inspection on Tuesday and Wednesday. We were blown away with the levels of support, whether that was through exceptional parental responses on Parent View or through kind words on the gate or to those individuals who chose to write letters directly to inspectors in support of the school.

Our children were also a credit to the school, being fantastic ambassadors for Castleton. The inspectors were impressed with how well behaved, articulate and passionate our students were over the two days.

Our inspection is now going through quality assurance. Until this process has been completed, we are unable to share the inspection outcomes. This will likely be either just before or just after Christmas, after which we will be pleased to share the findings.

From September 2024, schools no longer receive a single word overall effectiveness judgement (such as 'outstanding' or 'good'). However, individual subcategories will still receive a grading.

## **Christmas Jumper Swap Shop**

On Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, at the end of the school day, some kind parent volunteers will have a Christmas Jumper swap shop setup on the school playground (or inside, if conditions are poor). As with World Book Day, students are welcome to select a donated school jumper from this collection or choose to bring their own to our various days we are allowing jumpers to be worn (see below). Please can we ask that any jumpers from the swap shop are returned after all of these events, so that they can be used in future years.

Christmas jumpers may be worn on: Pantomime trip (5<sup>th</sup> December); Nativity performances (for those not in costume); Christmas dinner/party day (19<sup>th</sup> December).

## Whole School Pantomime Visit – Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December

We are looking forward to our joint Castleton and Glaisdale pantomime visit on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December. Children will be leaving school late morning and will be returning to school at approximately 4.30pm.
