

English

Fiction/non-fiction writing to our class text, which is *The Boy at the Back of the Classroom* by Onjali Rauf. We will also be writing our explanation texts on Volcanoes and writing a biography about a child's favourite sports person.

Maths

In maths this term, we will be covering:
Year 3 and 4- Fractions, Division
Year 5 and 6- Measures

Religious Education

We will be continuing work on our key questions from the spring term and then following this, the focus questions will be:

Y3/4- Why do people pray?

Y5/6- What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?

Geography

We will be learning about different types of settlements and land use understanding the geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom and a developing country.

French- The children will be building on the work they have already learnt with Mrs Thomas.

Design and Technology

This term we are learning about moving pictures and designing a moving book/ pictures using cams, pivots, slider etc based on *The Stone Age*. We will then move onto sewing and stuffed toys.

Art

This term in Art children will be working towards their Art Award. (More details to follow!)

Computing

The year 3/4 children will be learning about branching databases and graphing. The year 5/6 children will be learning about databases and 3D modelling.

History

This term in History we will learning all about Ancient Greece. The children be completing a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.

Music

We will be learning songs for the Summer play, focusing on singing with increasing fluency and listening with increasing oral memory.

Science

Year 3/ 4 will continue work on Sound and then move onto animals including humans.

Year 5/ 6 will continue work on Evolution and then move onto animals including humans.

Personal, Social and Health Education

In PSHE we will be covering Health and Well-being and Living in the Wider World.

The year 5 and 6 children will have separate sessions on *Growing and Changing*.
