

## English

Fiction/non-fiction writing linked to our class text which is High Rise Mystery by Sharna Jackson

We will also write an explanation text about how volcanoes are formed linked to our Geography work and instructions linked to our History topic.

## Geography

We will be learning about how volcanoes are formed and locate some of the famous ones from around the world. Also we will learn how earthquakes are created.

## Design and Technology

This term we are learning about moving pictures and designing a moving book/picture using cams, pivots, sliders etc.

**History** We are continuing our historical journey from the Stone Age to the Bronze and Iron Age. We are hoping to add in some virtual visits to a museum to help us to learn more about these periods.

**Science** We will be continuing working on states of matter/properties and changes of materials initially, then moving onto Sound (Y3/4) and Evolution and inheritance (Y5/6).

Later on in the term we will look at animals including humans.

**Maths** This term in maths we will be covering:

Y3/4 Multiplication, division, measures and fractions.

Y5/6 Fractions (x and division of fractions too), Decimals, Percentages and measures.

## Music

We will be looking into the history of music. Also recalling sounds with increasing aural memory. We will be composing and exploring tempo, texture, structure, duration and looking at musical notations.

**French** Numbers, my family and describing people plus recapping previous learning to perfect pronunciations and recall skills.

**Religious Education** The questions we will be focusing on this term are:

Y3/4 What do different people believe about God. Why are festivals important to religious communities.  
Y5/6 What would Jesus do? (Can we live by the values of Jesus in the 21st Century?)

## Other learning

Forest schools using tools and improving our garden area and gardening.
