English

During term, children will be studying 'Secrets of a Sun King' by Emma Carroll. The pupils will write a narrative, participate in a debate, study classical poetry, write a flashback story and create explanations based on their science learning. They will also create a piece of science fiction writing. As part of the writing process children will edit, redraft and publish each piece of writing.

Maths

This term in maths, Year 3 and 4 children will be covering multiplication and division, fractions, length, perimeter and area. Year 5 and 6 children will cover fractions, decimals and percentages, perimeter, area and volume.

Religious Education-

The questions we will be focusing on this term are 'It is better to express your beliefs in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity?' and 'What difference does it make to believe in Ahimsa, Grace and/or Ummah?'

Music

Miss Wilson will work with the children in music. They will be looking at composition of music using percussion instruments and continuing to develop an understanding of pitch and tone.

Geography

In geography the children will be making comparisons between Greece and the UK, looking at the countries, populations, quality of life and environments.

Science

Year 3 and 4 children will learn about rocks then Animals (including humans). Year 5 and 6 children will learn about Earth and Space then Animals (including humans). During these topics, children will be developing their skills in scientific enquiry and investigation.



French

We will be learning about transport and being able to explain where we live.

PSHE

This term children will be learning about Keeping Safe. They will cover keeping safe online, on phones, on the road, and with dangerous substances (medicines, alcohol and tobacco).

Design and Technology

This term the children will finish their electric vehicles. They will then make bread and evaluate the outcomes. They will be thinking about the nutrition, cooking methods and ingredients available.

Computing

Children will be continuing their work on coding and using 'Everyone can create drawing'. following the Apple Curriculum.

History

This term children will be learning about the Mayan civilization c. AD 900. We will plot events on timelines using centuries; we will annotate pictures of Mayan artefacts with notes to infer aspects of life at the time and give an account of an event from Mayan times which has shaped our lives today.

<u>Art</u>

This term children will be learning to cross stitch and sew. They will design and create a bookmark which incorporates cross stitch.

Spellings-Spellings will be given out on a Monday and children will be tested the following Monday.

Reading- Please continue to read with your child at home and read at least three times a week so they can be entered into the reading raffle.

<u>Times tables-</u> Children should continue to practise their times tables at home on TTRS and Hit the Button.

PΕ

During this term, children will be completing gymnastics, swimming and cricket. Swimming is on Mondays. During the first half term we will do gymnastics in the Village Hall on Fridays. During the second half term, cricket sessions will take place on Tuesdays.
