School Administrator

Peat Rigg Residential

Our Year 5 and 6 children will be heading off on an exciting adventure next week! On Wednesday, children will depart to Peat Rigg Outdoor Centre where they will take part in a range of outdoor adventurous activities, including abseiling, zipline, caving, archery, bushcraft and much more! The children will be attending the visit with children from Oakridge, Lealholm and Glaisdale Schools, helping them to forge and strengthen relationships with children from different schools.

Children should arrive at school at the normal time in outdoor clothing and footwear. They should have all their bags with them, containing the kit list sent out previously. Children will return on Friday mid-afternoon, in time for a normal collection at the end of the day (although we will inform you if we arrive back earlier, in case you would like an earlier collection of tired children!)
