#### **School Performance**

Please note that on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December the school will closed for a staff training day. For your information, staff will be receiving training on their assessment systems and how to deliver effective phonics provision. This is crucial to how we improve our practice in school and keep up with the most recent educational research.

#### **Year 6 Proposed Trip to Edinburgh**

We have had an overwhelmingly positive response to our questionnaire regarding a possible Year 6 trip to Edinburgh in July. We have provisionally booked accommodation for the visit and will be putting plans in place (after Christmas) to arrange formal consent and deposits, so that we can arrange activities and transportation.
